### PROGRAM

#### DAY 1 - LAVENDER COLOR

Upon arrival in Provence, all senses are awakened, smelling delicious fragrance and seeing dazzling color fields. Begin your trip by visiting **the Lavender Museum** created by a family of producers. This conservatory presents this emblematic flower in all these forms.

Dinner and overnight in your 3 \*\*\* hotel / restaurant in Avignon.

#### DAY 2 – THE LUBERON

After your breakfast,

Enjoy a discovery of **the most beautiful viewpoints of the Luberon**, his lavender fields, his authentic hilltop villages and Provençal landscapes, with a local guide.

Lunch in a restaurant in Gordes,

In the afternoon, enter in **the impressive Senanque Abbey** surrounded by lavender fields. A 12th century Cistercian monastery still inhabited by a monks community. A few kilometers away, visit **the famous village of Gordes** ranked among the most beautiful villages of France.

Dinner and overnight in the same hotel in Avignon.

#### DAY 3 – THE PROVENÇAL ALPS

Breakfast in the hotel,

Near the Verdon Canyon, the perfumed pathways of the « **Plateau de Valensole** » await you with windswept fields of lavender and wheat. During the morning, discover **a traditional lavender distillery**.

Lunch in a local restaurant

In the afternoon, enjoy an initiatory tour in **the kingdom of scents** and discover a manufactory of famous cosmetics and his museum,

Dinner and overnight in the same hotel.

#### DAY 4 – AROUND THE MONT VENTOUX

Departure after your last breakfast of the stay.

On the lavender route, the Mont Ventoux, named "**the Giant of Provence**" dominates the landscape from its 1912m high. Around, perched on a rocky spur, you visit **Sault, a charming village**.

End your journey in this place where dazzling **lavender fields is everywhere**.
